# End of Key Stage tests - SATs

**wb.14<sup>th</sup> May 2018:** New SATs in line with new NC.

- English Reading – Paper 1, Paper 2
  - English Writing – SPaG, ongoing Teacher Assessment
  - Maths – Paper 1 Arithmetic, Paper 2 Reasoning
  - Science – Teacher Assessment
- 
- KS1 SATs are used only to aid Teacher Assessment in these areas.
  - Teacher Assessment is ongoing throughout the year in all subjects.



# Homework

**Maths** – *Mathletics* activities will be set on Friday to be completed for the following Friday.

Times tables – 2,3,5,10X ongoing and tested throughout the year.

**Spelling** – on Friday spelling sheets go home to be tested the following Friday. Children will bring their spelling books home on Friday. Please return the book on Monday. **Spellings available on school website.**

Children will also be tested on the Y2 common exception words throughout the year.

**Reading** – books will go home on Monday and Friday. Please return books to school on Mondays and Thursdays.

**Learning log** – Learning log tasks/challenges will be set each term/half term linked to core and foundation subjects.

# Things to note

- The first day back at school is **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2017.**
- The children will line up next to the ramp when the bell rings. We will be outside to greet the children and take them into class.
