## 'The Best for Every Child'

At Cookridge Holy Trinity C of E (A) Primary we encourage, in all members of the community, a shared sense of awe and wonder as we grow closer to God.

We foster creativity and inquiring minds, learning through collaboration and interdependence to become motivated lifelong learners.

#### **Rationale**

At Holy Trinity Primary School we believe in the concept of lifelong learning and the idea that both children and adults learn new things every day. We maintain that learning should be a rewarding and enjoyable experience for everyone; it should be fun. High standards of personal presentation support our positive learning ethos.

Parents are asked for full support and co-operation to ensure that all children wear school uniform:

## Key Stage 1

#### **Boys**

Grey tailored trousers/long or short White polo shirt Navy sweatshirt with Cookridge Holy Trinity logo Grey Socks Black School Shoes – not trainers please Conventional sandals – summer (optional)

#### Girls

Grey skirt or Grey tailored trousers White polo shirt
Navy sweatshirt with Cookridge Holy Trinity logo
Navy Cardigan with Cookridge Holy Trinity neckband
White socks - blue or grey tights
Black school shoes/black sensible boots - not trainers or fashion boots please
Conventional sandals - summer (optional) to be worn with socks
Summer blue and white check dress (optional)

#### Games/P.E.

Gold T-shirt this can be worn with or without the Holy Trinity logo Navy shorts for both boys and girls Short white socks and pumps or trainers for games Bare feet for gymnastics and dance Navy tracksuit and school fleece if preferred for outdoors

#### Key stage 2

#### **Boys**

Grey tailored trousers
Navy V-neck pullover with Holy Trinity neckband
White shirt and school tie
Grey socks
Black school shoes - not trainers please
Conventional sandals – summer (optional) to be worn with socks

#### Girls

Grey skirt or Grey tailored trousers White shirt and school tie
Navy cardigan or Jumper with Holy Trinity neckband
White socks - blue or grey tights
Black school shoes/black sensible boots – not trainers or fashion boots please
Conventional sandals - summer (optional) to be worn with socks
Summer blue and white check dress (optional)

#### Games/P.E.

Gold T-shirt this can be worn with or without the Holy Trinity logo Navy shorts for both boys and girls Short white socks and pumps or trainers for games Bare feet for gymnastics and dance

Navy tracksuit and school fleece if preferred for outdoors

All clothing must be clearly marked with the pupil's name and all PE kits and pumps must be in a named drawstring bag.

In addition, we ask that an apron/shirt be provided for Art and Craft work in Key Stage 2.

Any valuables, including money, which may have to be brought to school, should be given to the class teacher for safekeeping during the day.

#### **Health and Safety**

There are several health and safety issues that inform our school policy as follows:

No jewellery should be worn except a wristwatch. Children with long hair need to have their hair tied back.

Pierced ears – If you wish your child to have pierced ears we suggest this is carried out in summer holidays to allow sufficient time to heal. A small simple plain stud can be worn in school. Your child will remove earrings that do not comply. The school takes no responsibility for lost earrings.

Earrings should be removed and left at home on PE days. If your child has had recently pierced ears then plasters must be supplied from home for the first eight weeks when doing PE. After that it is expected they will be removed for PE.

Staff will not attempt to remove or insert earrings for children.

## In addition:

Hairstyles – razored lines and haircuts which are below a number 2 are not allowed. Parents will be contacted if this is not adhered to and a plan agreed – i.e. 2 weeks given for the hair to grow out. It is then not expected that this will be repeated.

No make-up is to be worn in school-this includes nail varnish and stick on tattoos. Parents/carers will be contacted if the above is worn and the expectation is that it will be removed after school for the next day.

Coloured trainers are not permitted
