School Council meeting

Friday 25th January 2019 at 10am

Items to follow up from last meeting:

- **Lunchtimes** – Discussed that there are still moments on the playground where people are ruining games. Said that rules need to be made for the cricket games and basketball games and that they need to be made clear to everyone in our school. People run through the games which ruin it, discussed the possibility of coning off areas. School councillors are going to create a powerpoint to be shared with pupils about lunchtime expectations and behaviours and this will be shared with classes as well as the games timetable.
- **VR headsets** – Miss Wynd told the children that we are going to be having our next school council meeting on the 8th Feb, where someone will be coming in to show VR headsets. That we will need to think how we could use these in our lessons. We talked about how good it would be to see places in other countries that we haven't been able to visit but also to use a 360 camera to make our own so people could experience things that we have experienced eg – robinwood, zipwires etc. We talked about funding of these and whether we could pitch to the governors or the PTA if it is something we would like or even raise the money ourselves.
- **No Pen Day** – Discussed the potential of having a day in the summer term where pens aren't used at all. We will need to come up with clear rules (are crayons, colouring pencils allowed). Children were really excited as they felt that it would mean thinking out of the box and having more time using other things in school like the ipads, PE equipment, computing equipment, outdoor learning etc.
- **Twitter** – Discussed that the school might be starting a twitter account. Could the school council alongside the school teacher do a tweet a week about things happening in their class from a pupil perspective. We discussed other social media platforms – youtube, Instagram. The children said that it would show everyone how great our school is and make everyone want to come and we could get more pupils at our school and make even more friends.

We discussed that we weren't going to mention the VR headsets with pupils in our class until we have seen them as we don't want to get peoples hopes up if we aren't impressed and don't want them.
