

English

Our Literacy will link to the theme of WWII, and we will be reading 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas'

It will include: descriptive writing, diary entries, letter writing, factual events

Spelling and Grammar revision

Whole class comprehension and guided groups to develop written comprehension answers

Science

To recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago

To recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents

To identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Maths

Main strands: fractions, decimals, percentages .

Including: Knowing what percent means, knowing what fraction means, simplifying fractions, ordering and comparing fractions, multiplying by 10, 100 and 1,000, dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000, multiplying decimals by integers, dividing decimals by integers, using division to solve problems, understanding decimals as fractions, and converting fractions to decimals
