Discussion

1. We looked at some of the behaviours recorded in the lunchtime book that Y6 are responsible for if they work as a door monitor. We discussed some of the behaviour recorded and some possible sanctions for that behaviour to make it improve. The decision was:
 - If you are not following lunchtime rules (e.g. being polite, going outside when asked to) you will be given a reminder by the Y6 door monitors, then a warning, then your name will be written in the book and shown to Mrs Casling. She will speak to that person, and decide if it is an amber card or 5 minutes off green time.
 - If your name appears in the book more than once in one week you need to see Mrs Casling on Friday afternoon and you may miss some green time.
 - If it is more serious and someone is not behaving properly then ask a member of dinner staff for help, and they will speak to Mrs Casling if necessary
