We move onto the recorders next half term.



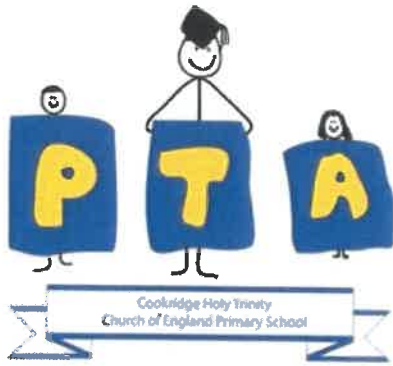
