#### 3 -ed sentences

- Frighten<u>ed</u>, exhaust<u>ed</u>, confus<u>ed</u>, they raced from the robber.
- Terrifi<u>ed</u>, alarm<u>ed</u>, startl<u>ed</u>, they hurtled through the dark, sinister woodland.
- Confused, troubled, worried, she hid behind a towering stone wall.

These sentences are very good for showing us the emotional state of a Character.

## Ad, same ad sentences

- He was a <u>reckless</u> runner, <u>reckless</u> because he needed to be.
- He was a <u>smart</u> dresser, <u>smart</u> because he had the money to buy the best.

This is a great way to emphasise the adjective in a sentence without it sounding boring.
