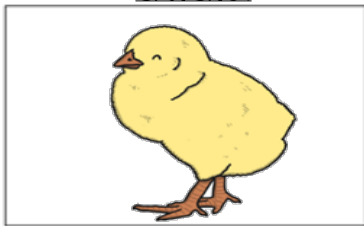

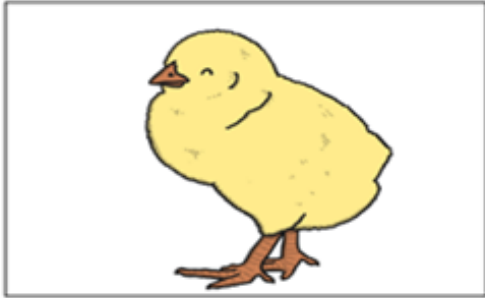

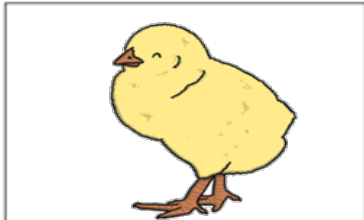

How to look after chicks...

1. First carefully place the eggs into the incubator. It must be kept at 37.7 degrees so the chicks are warm enough to hatch.

2. When they start to hatch, set up the brooder. You will need to put newspaper and sawdust at the bottom and give the chicks some food and water.

How to look after chicks...

3. You need to move them into the brooder when they are nice and fluffy. To do this carefully scoop them up by cupping your hands and gently place them into the brooder.

4. You need to clean them out every day. When you clean them out, move the chicks into a separate, safe box.

5. You need to feed them twice a day the food needs to be poured into the bowl. The chicks need to be fed chick crumbs. Also change the water once a day.



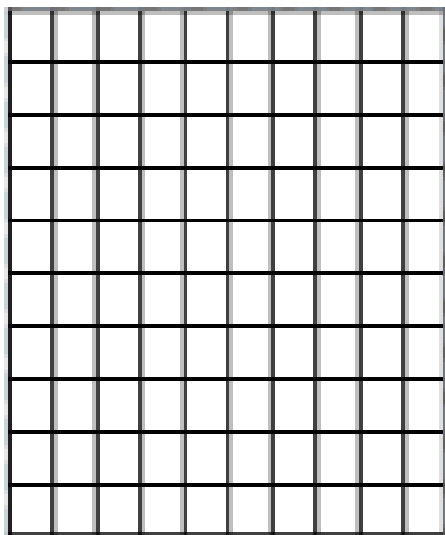

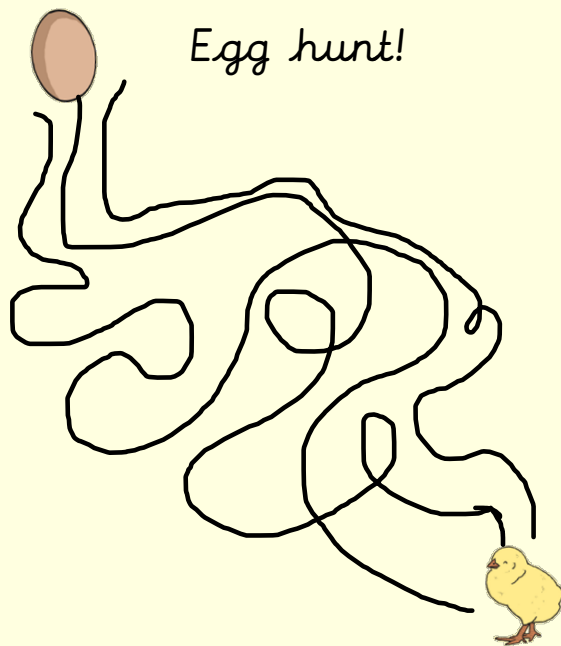
