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Today you are going to use your math skills to help your new teacher get to know you a little better!

My age:
 $12 \times 2 =$

My birth date:
 $13 \times 2 - 2 =$

My birth month:
 $15 \div 5 - 2 =$

The number of people in my family:
 $2 + 3 =$

My shoe size:
 $18 \div 3 =$



The number of pets I own:
 $3 \times 0 =$

How much fruit I eat each day:
 $3 \times 2 =$

How many clubs I am in:
 $1 \times 3 =$

The number of letters in my name:
 $4 \times 2 =$

My house number:
 $6 \div 3 =$

The number of people in my class:
 $10 \times 3 + 1 =$

My Year group:
 $2 \times 2 =$

You can use

$+$, $-$, \times , \div

to help create numbers related to you!

For example, if you are 7 years old you could

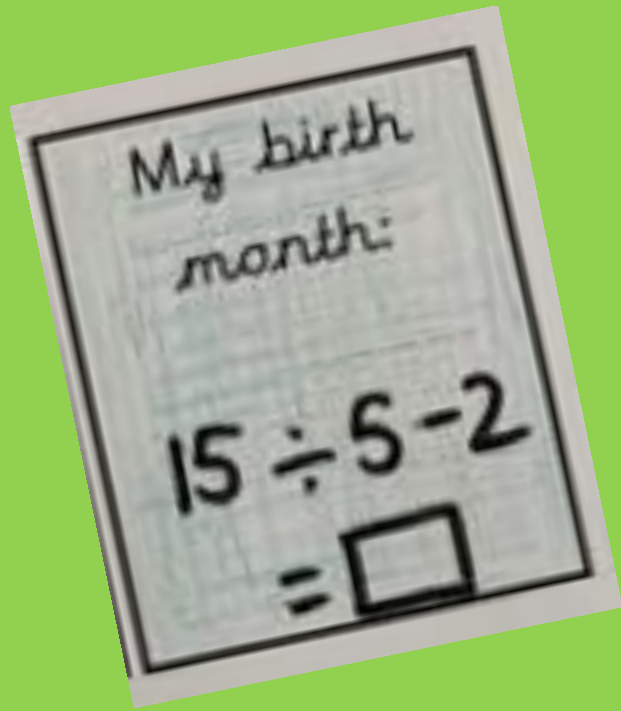
make the number 7 by:

$$28 - 21 = 7$$

$$35 \div 5 = 7$$

$$7 = 2 + 5$$

$$7 = 2 \times 3 + 1$$



How could you create a number sentence to show the month you were born in?

E.g. January = 1, February = 2, March = 3

How could you create a number sentence to show the number of clubs you are part of?

E.g. Brownies, swimming, football, gymnastics etc...
