COVID-19 Home – School Agreement

As parents we shall try to:

- Make sure my child attends school each day at their allocated time, on time, and is properly equipped.
- Make sure that my child is dropped off and picked up at the correct gate – on time, during this COVID-19 crisis, by only one parent.
- Follow government guidance around prevention and response to infection (including making use of NHS Test, Trace and self-isolation when applicable).
- Make sure my child’s uniform is clean.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect his/her work, attendance or behaviour.
- Support the school’s policies and guidelines for good behaviour, uniform, homework and against bullying (including maintaining expectations around regular hand cleaning, catch-it, bin-it, kill-it and social distancing).
- Support my child in doing his/her homework.
- Engage with all parental communication.

The School staff will try to:

- Care for your child’s safety and well-being at all times.
- Ensure that your child washes/gels their hands at regular intervals during the school day.
- Ensure that your child’s contact with other children and adults is kept to a minimum within their bubble and contact with other bubbles is avoided (where possible).
- Staff will promote good hand and respiratory hygiene – regular hand/gel washing alongside catch-it, bin-it, kill-it and good ventilation in the classroom.
- Follow government guidance around prevention and response to infection (including making use of NHS Test, Trace and self-isolation when applicable).
- Minimise contact and maintain social distancing wherever possible.
- Ensure regularly cleaning including cleaning frequently touched surfaces often.
- Provide a balanced curriculum and meet the individual learning needs of your child.
- Support your child in achieving their personal and academic potential.
- Maintain high standards of work and behaviour.
- Keep you informed on a regular basis about general school matters and about your child’s progress.

As a pupil I shall try to:

- Ensure that I wash/gel my hands properly at regular intervals during the school day as instructed to do so by an adult in my school.
- Do all my schoolwork and homework as well as I can and use only the equipment that is made available to me.
- Bring the equipment that I need for the day.
- Be polite, well behaved and helpful to others at all times whilst maintaining a social distance from each other.
- Wear the school uniform and be clean, smart and tidy.
- Care for school property, keep our school rules and ensure that I am doing everything I can to keep safe and keep others safe.
