Mrs Sen has worked across both Year 1 and Year 2. She also works in the library so you might see her at lunchtimes and after school.


## Mrs Seelig


Mrs Seelig and Mrs Sen help with our reading a lot and they can't wait to share your reading books with you.



# The Morning Routine

(It's a bit like what you do in reception)

- \* Every morning your teacher will collect you from the playground. 1A stand on the yellow circle and 1RB stand on the red circle.
- \* You will have your own peg for your coat. Your water bottle goes in the tray. If you have a packed lunch it goes on the trolley.
- \* Your school bag goes in your new tray. It is up to you to remember to give letters and reading books to your teacher.



# At the end of the day

1RB will be collected from the bottom gate of the Year 1 outside area.

1A will be collected from the gate straight in front of the door.

You must tell us you have seen your grown up before we let you go.

# The first days in Year One

It is important that you feel safe and happy in Year One and we will spend time:

- Learning classroom routines
- Learning classroom rules
- Talking to the teachers and asking questions



- Doing some English and Maths.
- Reading and practicing hand writing/letter formation
- Exploring the classroom activities

Each project will be 2 pages long.


Make sure you and your grown up read the guidelines on the front cover.

Monday and Wednesday.


Check your PE kit with
