

For years, HUMANS have been USING drawn or painted images to capture real life.




In the Middle Ages a cartoon was a planning sketch for a main piece of art (a painting, a tapestry, a stained glass window, etc).

From the 1500s to the 1700s people got the news through short printed works that had many pictures. Lots of these pictures were political cartoons. Political cartoons became common throughout Europe and the United States during the 1800s.



By the 1900S people enjoyed the FUNNY pANNELS and comic Strips More than the political cartoons.



With the TWENTIETH century came FILM and TV. Cartoons were transferred FROM paper into animation ON a SCREEN.



Now, cartoons are everywhere; in books, in films, even in adverts!



There are lots of different companies who make cartoons.
