How the charity was started?

Work began in 1945, when we were founded by British and Irish churches to help refugees following the Second World War.

What the charity does?

For more than 70 years, we have provided humanitarian relief and long-term development support for poor communities worldwide, while highlighting suffering, tackling injustice and championing people's rights.

Who the charity helps?

Everyone is equal in the sight of God. Yet we live in a world where poverty still persists. Poverty is an outrage against humanity. It robs people of their dignity and lets injustice thrive. But together we have the power to transform lives. For over 70 years, Christian Aid have been standing with the poorest of our neighbours. We work in 37 countries, with people of all faiths and none, to stand up for dignity, equality and justice.

How does the charity follow Jesus' teachings?

Everything the charity does is in response to God's gift to the world, of his son Jesus Christ. Jesus promised 'good news' for the poor and 'freedom' for the oppressed, calling us to action.

Jesus called his followers to 'love God and love your neighbour'. Through his life and teaching, his death and his resurrection, he inspired his followers to love God, love their neighbours and long for justice.

How can people get involved?

Children can raise money for the charity by holding a cake sale, going on a sponsored walk or run. The Worship Team could do an assembly and help to make everyone in school aware of the charity. People could donate money using the Christian Aid website page.
