

answer to prayers.

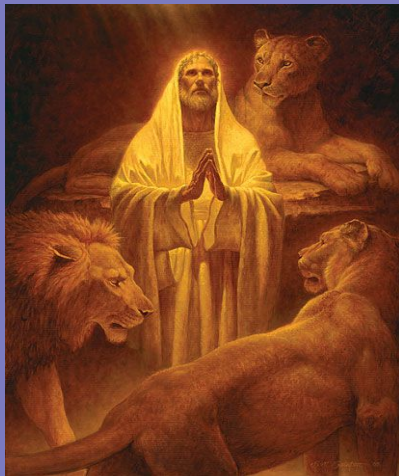

“So I tell you, ask, and God will give to you. Search, and you will find. Knock, and the door will open for you. Everyone who asks will receive. The one who searches will find. And everyone who knocks will have the door opened.

The answer...

LUKE 11:9-13: GOD IS LIKE A LOVING FATHER

In the Bible verses, when Jesus talks about prayer he compares God to a kind father. Would a father give his child snakes and scorpions when the hungry child asks for fish and eggs? No.

Here's the good news: God is even better than our parents, and loves to give his children good things - including the Holy Spirit, to live with those who trust in him. Christians say, if God is a father/ mother to us all, then we are all children of God. What kind of father is God? Christians rely on verses like these to assert that God's fatherhood is good, bringing a person well-being, wholeness and peace.

Think about the opening of the Lord's Prayer: 'Our Father in heaven...'

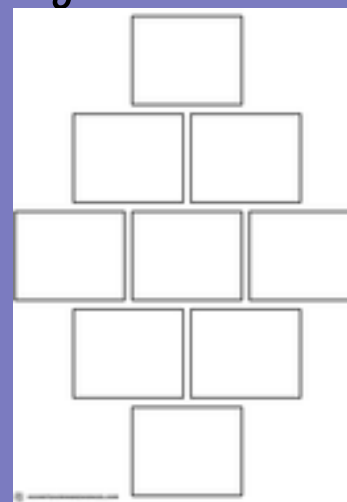
Christians believe God loves humans and has given us many gifts.
