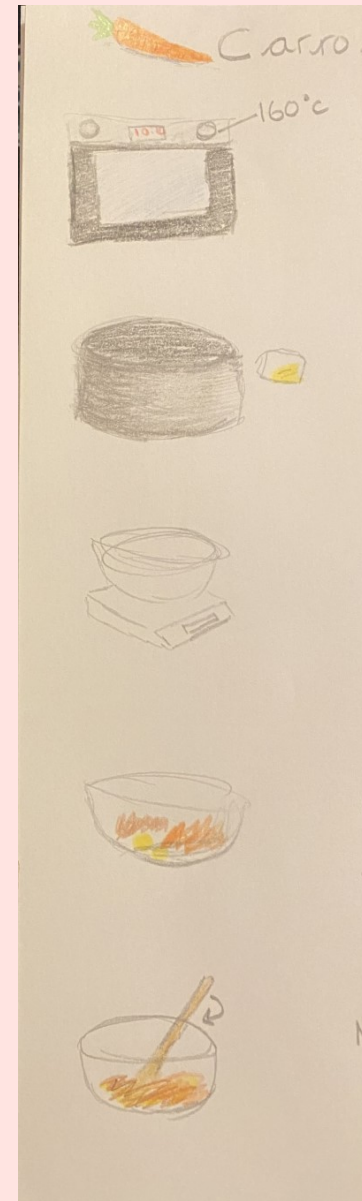

We are now going to think about the types of words we'll need to write our instructions:

★ Bossy verbs - also known as imperatives. These verbs tell you to do something like a command or order.

- grease, weigh, add, pour, mix

We are now going to think about the types of words we'll need to write our instructions:

★ Adverbs - Adverbs describe verbs. They give us more detail such as how to do something.

- Pour *carefully*, stir *gently*.
