




Grid references



"Grid references are numbers that represent locations on a map using 'Cartesian co-ordinates', they are numbered to provide a unique map reference (location). Usually the numbers represent the directions of north and east."

Grid references




How do we use a grid reference?

How can I tell someone about a location, using a grid reference?

Is it important which way round I put my numbers?


How do we use a grid reference?

- The first number tell us how far along the right the place is, and the second number tells us how far up the place is. The numbers will be for the bottom left corner of the square.

How can I tell someone about a location, using a grid reference? - You would give them the numbers that show where the location is.

Is it important which way round I put my numbers? - Yes, you must list the bottom numbers (horizontal ++) first, then the side numbers (vertical +)



Lets see if you were accurate using co-ordinates for the following locations:


- Hadley Lake (09,02)
