

L.O. to know the physical features
of Italy

Last lesson, we began to look at the physical features of Italy using different maps to help us.

Let's look again at a topological map...



Topological Map: the colours show how high or low the land is

Key

Orange- Very steep

Yellow- Steep

Green- Flat

How steep is the land in Italy compared to the UK?

Today, we are going to use a topological map of Italy to help us create our own salt dough version!



Example of a topological salt-dough map



Step one: Get the Italy outline template or draw your own outline on a piece of paper or card.



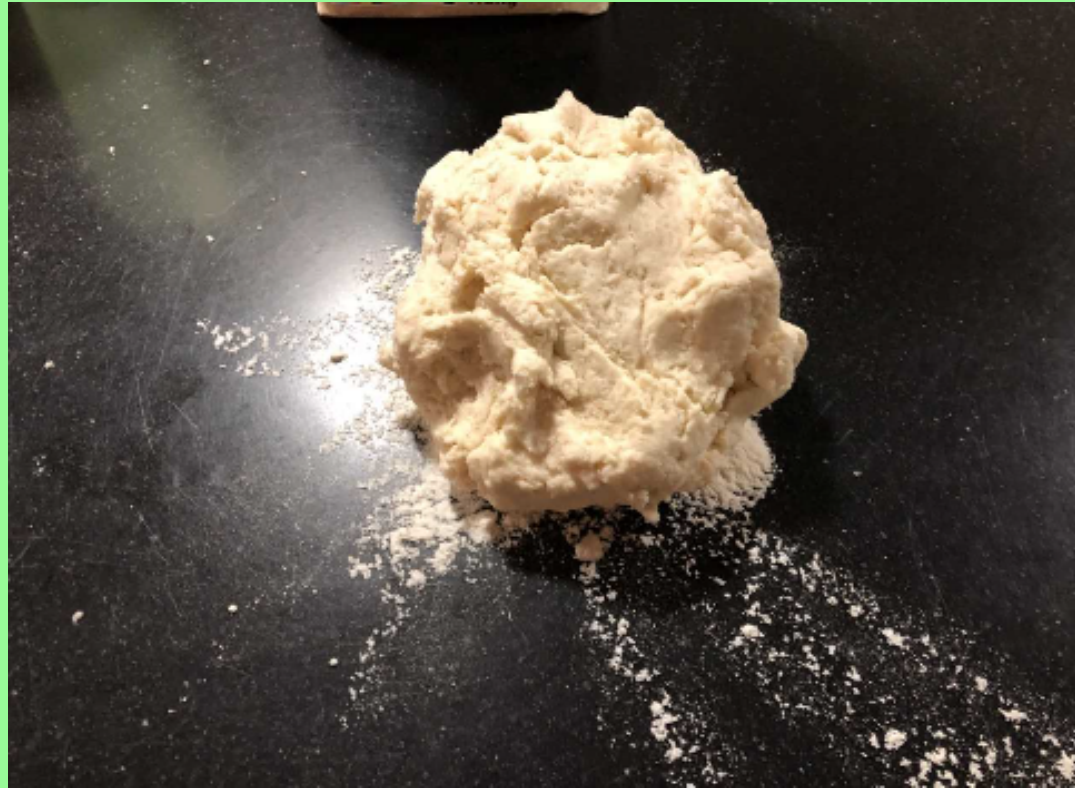
Step two: Gather your ingredients for your salt-dough recipe.

There are lots available online but we use: 250g plain flour, 125g salt, 125ml water (approximately).
