Today we are going to do a RIC. Use the text to answer the questions. Remember to answer in full sentences.

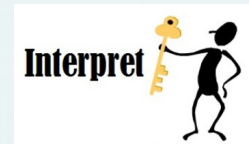
The Wizard of Oz

'Give me the sparkly, ruby slippers!' she shouted.

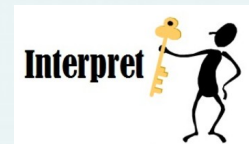
