Clue 1

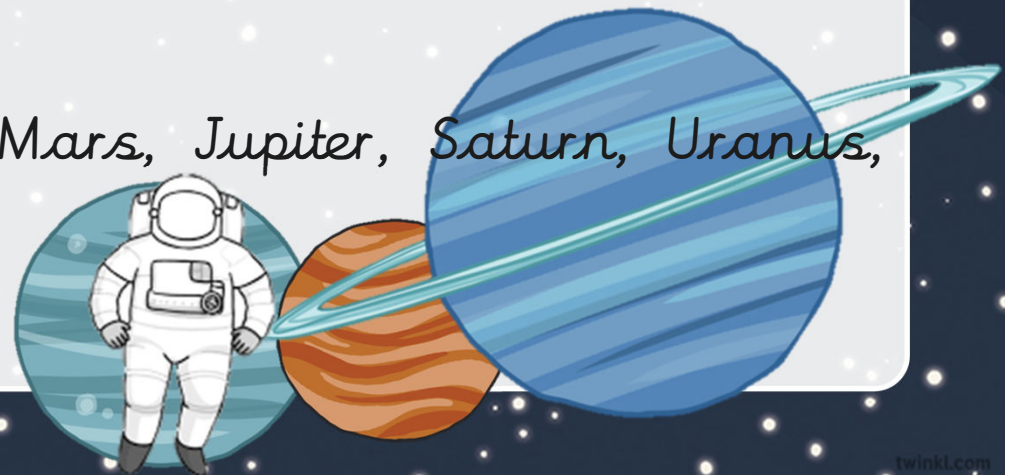
Starting with the planet closest to the Sun, which is the correct order of the planets? The first digit of the code will correspond with the number next to the answer.

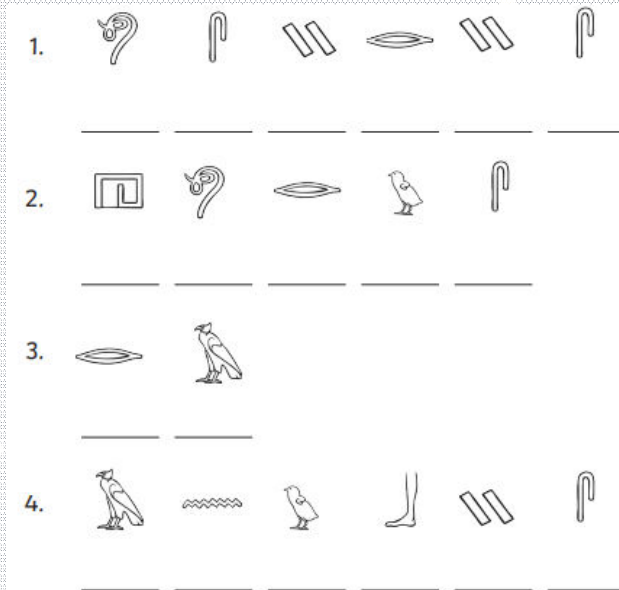
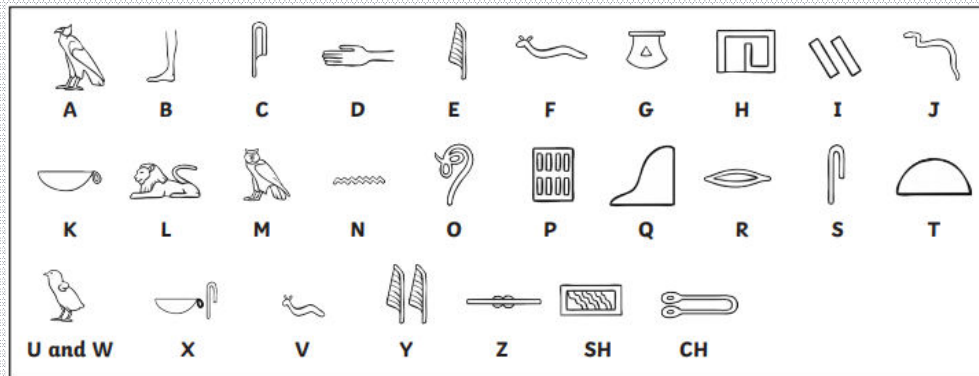
Clue 5

Clue 6

Clue 7

Order the Roman timeline cards in chronological order.
Remember BC comes first! The 7th digit for your escape code is the date of the 5th event on the timeline.

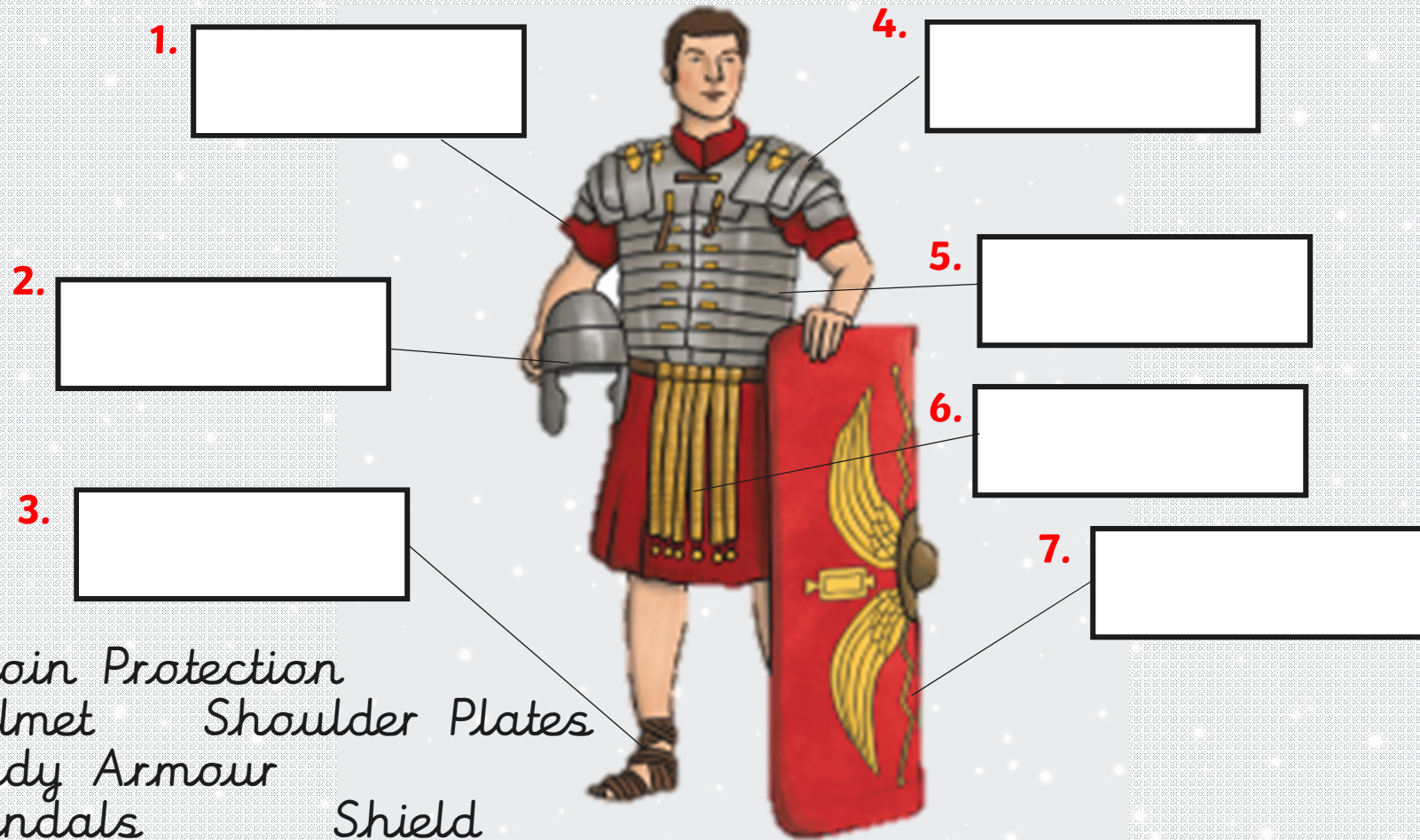

Use the word bank to label the Roman Soldier. What is the number that is labelled as the shield? This is the 8th digit of the escape code.

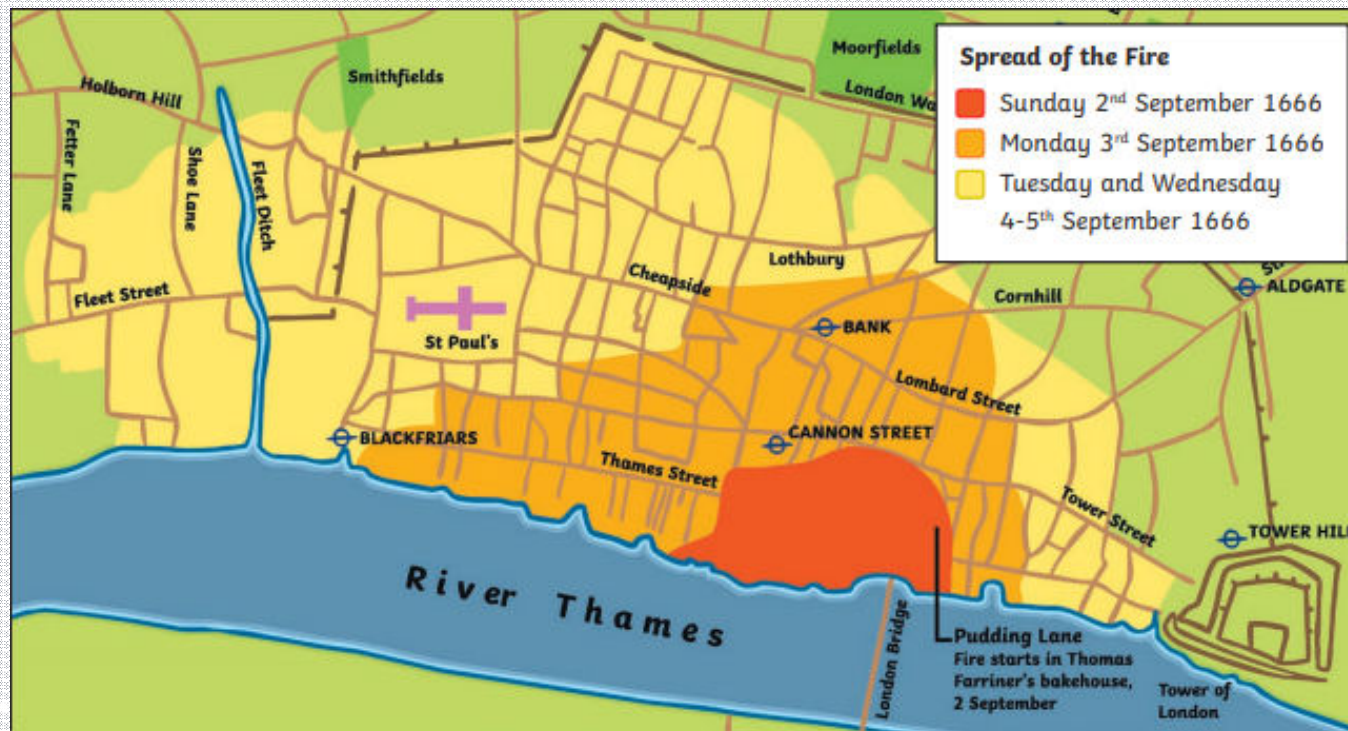


Clue 9

Clue 13

Examine the sources of evidence from WW2. How many nurses were sadly killed in the bombing of Galliford house? This is the 13th digit of the escape code.

Source 1



This is the southern approach to Westminster Bridge, the photograph shows bomb damage to the nurses home (Galliford House) attached to St. Thomas's Hospital. The attack, on the night of 8th/9th September 1940 left six nurses killed and many injured. During the course of WW2 the hospital was bombed twelve times.

Source 2



British Red Cross volunteer, at work at London Bridge air raid shelter. The uniforms were practical for clambering over debris.

Source 3



Red Cross nurses and stretcher bearers prepare to transport an injured man to hospital after an air raid.

Source 4

The British nation is stirred and moved as it never has been at any time in its long and famous history, and they mean to conquer or to die. What a triumph the life of these battered cities is over the worst that fire and bomb can do!

The terrible experiences and emotions of the battlefield are now shared by the entire population. Old men, little children, the crippled, the veterans of former wars, aged women, the hard-pressed citizen, the sturdy workman with his hammer in the shipyard, the members of every kind of ARP service, are proud to feel that they stand in the line together with our fighting men. This, indeed, is a grand, heroic period of our history, and the light of glory shines upon all.

Winston Churchill, broadcast 27 April 1941

Source 5

All reports from London are agreed that the population is seized by fear. The Londoners have completely lost their self-control.

Nazi radio broadcast, 18 September 1940

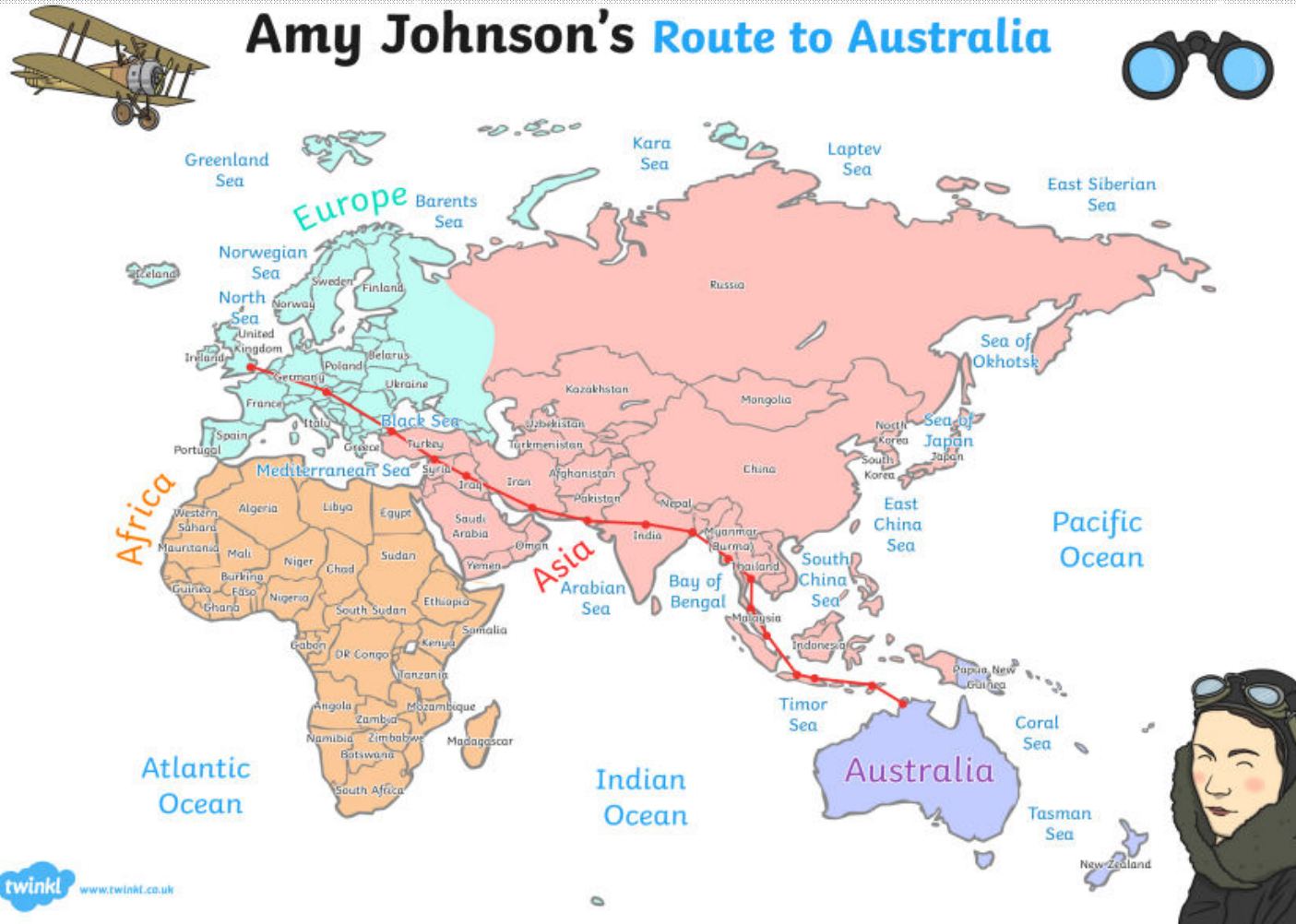
Source 6

Down came the bombs. You could hear the HEs going over the top with a low whistling sound. After a moment or two they started in with the incendiaries and dropped a Molotov over the docks. There was fire in every direction. The City was turned into an enormous, loosely-stacked furnace, belching black smoke.

Clue 14

Including the UK, how many countries in Europe did Amy Johnson travel through to reach Australia? That number of countries is the 14th digit of the escape code.



Clue 15

What date of December did Rosa Parks refuse to give up her seat on the bus? This is the last digit of the escape code.

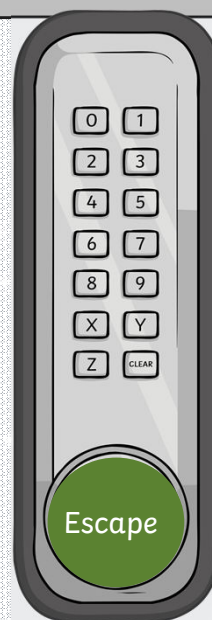

Between the 16th and 19th century, millions of African people were sold into slavery. In 1865, even though slavery had ended, many African Americans were not treated fairly. They still couldn't vote, do certain jobs or sit with the white people on buses, restaurants or parks. Rosa Parks was an African American who wanted to improve black people's lives. On December 1st she was on the bus and refused to give up her seat for a white person. The police were called and she was arrested. A campaign called the "Bus Boycott" was started by Martin Luther King and called for black people to boycott (stop using) the buses. Eventually the campaign was successful and on the 21st December 1956, the segregation between white people and black people in Alabama stopped.



Now you have solved the clues it is time to enter the 15 digit code to travel back to 2021!
