


What do all of these objects have in common?

- You were asked to find objects beginning with a letter, or having a letter written on it, that spells the word, "ITALY!"
- You were asked to find pasta, pasta sauce and a pizza topping which are all foods from Italy! You were also asked to find coffee and Italians love an espresso!

- ■You were asked to find a pair of jeans. Did you know the Italians invented jeans? Sailors in Genoa wore them in the 17th Century! It is thought that the word "Jeans" comes from the French word for Genoa, "Genes."
- You were asked to find a coin. The very first banks are traced back to medieval Italy and the word "bank" is derived from the Italian word, "banco" or "banca!"

- You were asked to find an object that links to music.
 Radios were invented by an Italian inventor and electrical engineer, Gugielemo Marconi, who sent and received the first transatlantic radio signal in 1901. His pioneering invention won him a Nobel Prize (prestigious award) for Physics and was used on board the Titanic, saving hundreds of lives in the disaster. Pianos were also invented by Bartolomeo Cristofori in 1700.
- You were asked to find a newspaper. Newspapers were invented in Venice in 1556 when the Venetian government decided it would be useful to keep citizens updated on local events and political news so they created a monthly newspaper.
