A covered urn used in ancient Egyptian burials to hold the entrails and other visceral organs from an embalmed body.

Belonging to the very distant past and no longer in existence

A formal writing system used in Ancient Egypt consisting of different symbols and shapes.

A structure with a square or triangular base and sloping sides that meet in a point at the top, especially one built of stone as a royal tomb in ancient Egypt.

The process of preserving a dead body as a mummy.

A large vault, typically an underground one, for burying the dead.

A waterless, desolate area of land with little or no vegetation, typically one covered with sand.
