Monday:

Tuesday

Reading and spelling practice at home.

Wednesday

Mathletics tasks set linked to current learning. Tasks will need to be completed by the following Wednesday. Sometimes we will set times table practice on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) as the weekly math's homework. If there are any problems with computer access, please let us know.

Thursday

Reading and spelling practice at home.

Friday

Children will be tested on their spellings.
