At the age of 21, Victoria married her cousin, Albert of Saxe-Coburg Gotha, a German Prince. They married on the 10th February 1840 at the Chapel Royal in St. James's Palace.

Most of Queen Victoria's children married into other royal families of Europe.

Her husband Albert died in 1861 at the young age of 42.

She mourned his death for almost 10 years.

For the rest of her reign she wore black.

During her time as Queen, Victoria survived seven assassination attempts, partly because she had become unpopular for hiding away after Albert's death.

However, Queen Victoria became well loved as she became older. During this time, there was the Industrial Revolution when machines were developed that could run whole factories. Many more ships, buildings and bridges were built.

The Victorian Empire
