English -

Linking in with our topic "North America,"

Pupils will study the novel Holes by Louis Sachar which is set in rural Texas. As part of the topic, they will: write newspaper reports, character descriptions, letters, perform drama, and comparisons between the USA and UK. Children will use VR headsets to discover New York and write persuasive pieces on visiting the Big Apple. We will discover what life was like in America during the 50's and learn about segregation and the work of Martin Luthor King and the impact he had on today's world. We will go back further in time and learn about the slave trade between Europe, America and Africa. Children will encounter some difficult topics regarding segregation, starvation, drought, racism and isolation.

Science- Changes and Properties of Materials

Pupils will investigate the properties of various materials and their uses. The children will conduct practical experiments linked to the processes of dissolving and separating materials from solvents such as evaporation, filtration, sieving and magnetic attraction. The children will investigate the changes that happen to materials when heated or cooled where they will grow their own crystals and bake Christmas biscuits!
