

Literacy –

Key texts: You Choose, The Three Little Pigs, Goldilocks, Handa's surprise, Nursery rhymes

Key skills:

Listening and attention skills

Sequencing key events of familiar story

Communication skills—sharing ideas

Ordering and writing name

Hear initial sounds

Oral blending and segmenting

Blending written cvc words using taught GPC

Begin to form letters correctly for taught graphemes (lower and upper case)

Maths

Matching and sorting— match and sort objects into sets based on attributes such as shape, size and colour.

Comparing amounts—use language more than, fewer than and the same as to compare quantities of natural objects and within provision.

Comparing size, mass and capacity— learn that objects can be compared and ordered according to their size, mass and capacity.

Patterns— copy, continue and create simple repeating patterns.

Counting principles—develop one-to-one correspondence, stable order and cardinality.

Five frames—become familiar in using five frames to support understanding of 1-5

Subitising— Don't count, see the amount! Begin to see amount of arrangements 13.
