# Homework

**Monday** - Spelling sheet and list to learn for Friday test (available on website) and reading sticker.

**Tuesday** - Reading (20 minutes reading and a detailed comment in the reading record) and spellings practise.

**Wednesday** - Mathletics set weekly ready for the following week.

**Thursday** - Reading (20 minutes reading and a detailed comment in the reading record) and spellings practise.

**Friday** - Children to bring in their homework diary to be marked. Reading (20 minutes reading and a detailed comment in the reading record).

Homework is checked regularly and expected to be done to a high standard. Please ensure you sign your child's homework diary each week to show us that they have completed it. Spellings sheets are not required to be handed into school.

# Expectations in Year 5

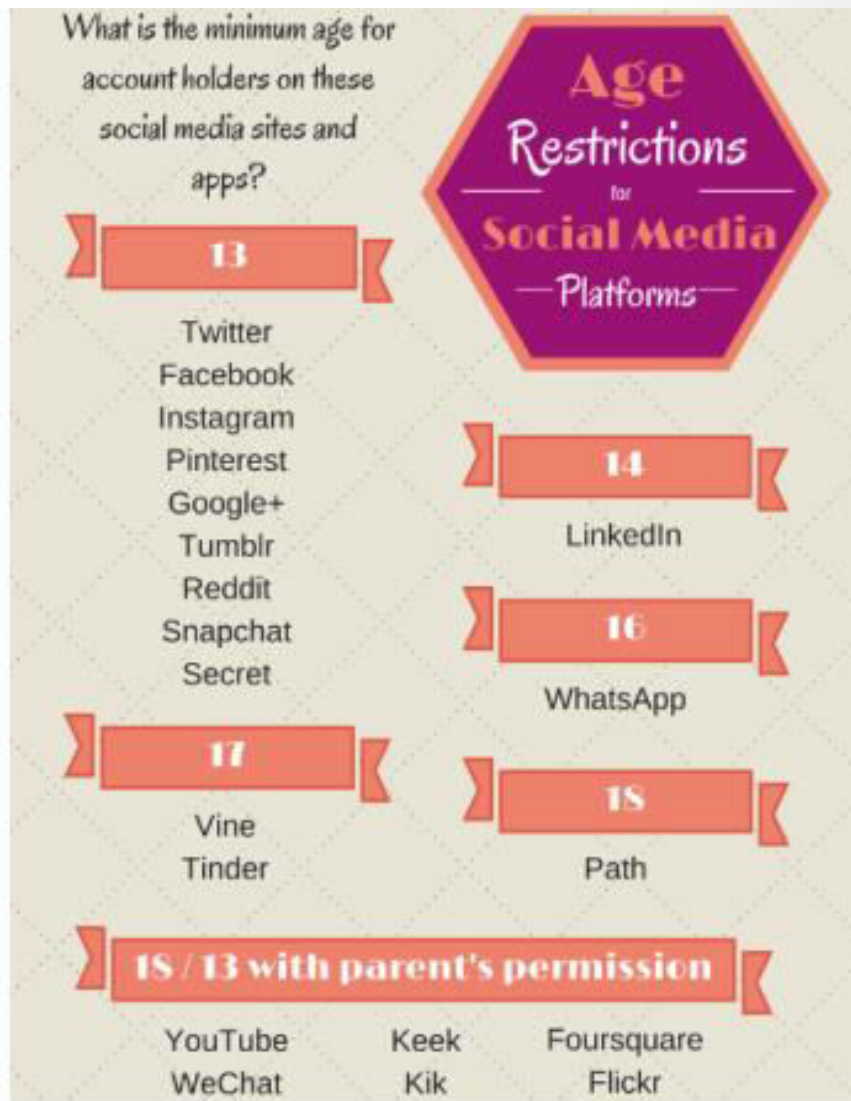
- Classroom expectations - We follow our Golden rules and classroom rules to earn Green Time.
- Perfect playtime behaviour and lining up, tidy lockers and cloakroom area
- Children have, for the last 2 years, been provided with their own pencil case and school equipment. This is TBC.
- Passports and Trinity cards are used for rewards
- Your child must remember to wear the correct uniform and P.E. kit and bring in water bottles.
- No phones should be in school, unless absolutely necessary. They should NOT be visible on the playground before or after school. To be handed in to the teacher each morning to be stored safely and returned at the end of the day.
- Medication in school e.g. inhalers, glasses to be labelled.



Please be vigilant with social media and check which apps your child is using. We would advise against group chats and posting photographs.

They should not be using Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp etc... without your permission/close supervision, especially group chats.

We promote e-safety at school and would appreciate your support with this at home.
