English

Linking in with our topic, *Titanic* we will be writing newspaper articles about the sinking. We will write poetry from the perspective of the iceberg and create our own detective mystery story. The children will practise their reading and comprehension skills in each lesson by answering VIPERS (Vocabulary, Infer, Predict, Explain, Retrieve, Summarise) questions. They will read a range of genres in guided reading and reading homework. They will practice spelling, punctuation and grammar in line with the new national curriculum.

We will compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases

We will observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius ($^{\circ}$ C)
