What happens when my child cames to school on Wednesday 12th?

Your child will need to be dressed in their dress down clothes as they will be doing activities during that afternoon. Please ensure your child is wearing weather appropriate clothing e.g. jumpers, trainers, warm socks or sunhat.

What do we do with their luggage?

You and your child will meet the year 5 staff in the main hall from 8:30-8:50 and drop off any bags which will then be given a luggage tag. You will then go back onto the school playground and line up as normal at 8:50. If your child attends breakfast club, they will keep their luggage with them until a member of year 5 staff is in the hall.

What is the departure time?

The coach has been booked for a departure time of 10:45. If you wish to, you will be able to wave your child off from Green Lane.

Will there be any communication while my child is away?

Mobile phones are not allowed on the trip. We encourage the children to fully immerse themselves in the experience therefore you will only be contacted by a teacher if there are any medical issues/emergencies whilst your child is away. There will be a blog which will go up in the late evening of each day on the school website so you can find out what they have been doing!

How could I support my child's independence whilst away?

If your child struggles with independence, it might be useful to clearly label separate bags with clothes for your child to wear on each day.

(For example: Thursday, Friday, Spare clothes/underwear for emergencies)

What happens when my child first arrives at Newby Wiske?

We will arrive at Newby Wiske at approximately midday. The children will drop off their luggage in the luggage storage room and then eat their packed lunch in the cafeteria. They will enjoy activities throughout the afternoon and evening.

What activities will my child take part in?

There will be a mixture of climbing, land and water activities for the children to enjoy. All will be supervised by trained staff ansite.

What food will my child be having?

All food allergies/dietary requirements have already been discussed in person with the catering staff. There is a wide range of hot and cold meals including a salad bar for breakfast, lunch and dinner. There will be something for all preferences.

Will my child have a choice of who they are with in groups and dorms?

The children have already been given the opportunity to express who they would like to share a room with and group choices for activities during the day. The evening activities will be held with all children so they can interact with everyone. A member of Holy Trinity staff will be assigned to each group.

What time will my child return to school?

Our coach is due to arrive back at school at approximately 2pm. Please collect your child at the end of the normal school day at 3:30pm. If your child attends after school club, they will attend as normal with their luggage.
