English

The reading and writing units of work link to our Autumn topic, "United States of America." Pupils will study the novel, 'Holes' by Louis Sachar, which is set in rural Texas. As part of the topic, they will write a descriptive text and a persuasive letter. The children will focus on their writing skills; including a range of spelling, punctuation and grammar. Additionally, the children will also study the poem, "Statue of Liberty" by Paul Perro. They will learn about the vocabulary used, identify the features of poetry and answer test style comprehension questions. The children will also practice their fluency of reading, focussing on the intonation, emphasis on certain words and pace when they perform the poem to an audience.

Science- Changes and Properties of Materials

Pupils will investigate the properties of various materials and their uses. The children will conduct practical experiments linked to the processes of dissolving and separating materials from solvents such as evaporation, filtration, sieving and magnetic attraction. The children will investigate the changes that happen to materials when heated or cooled where they will grow their own crystals.
